Established in 2004, the company operates a drama academy, providing quality drama and performing arts training for ages four right through to adults, along with a production company, producing both professional & student performed English theatre for children and families.

We currently have locations in **Geneva** (our headquarters), **Zurich**, **Zug**, **Basel**, **Lausanne** and **Annecy** (France) and teach over 700 students per week.

### WHAT WE'RE LOOKING FOR

We are currently looking for experienced and enthusiastic drama, singing and dance teachers to join our teams in both full time and part time roles.

Candidates should ideally have Swiss, Schengen or EU nationality. Full-time positions will require the applicant to relocate permanently to Switzerland for the duration of the contract, however, for part-time contracts, this can be discussed further.

Initial contracts are for one-year, with the option to extend by mutual agreement, with relocation assistance provided (international travel costs plus more) for full time roles.



### JOB SPECIFICATION

#### The Academy Teacher will:

- Take responsibility for the teaching of their allocated classes each week
- Teach other workshops as required including school and summer workshops.
- For Acting and Singing applicants, coach group and private sessions for LAMDA Examinations, as well as students preparing for college auditions.
- Make notes on lesson plans, including individual student comments and file these weekly.
- Hold parent/student/teacher meetings once per year
- Nurture the individual and care deeply for all students
- Manage and deliver open classes
- Produce Showcase performances for all classes at the end of the year (June).

#### For Fulltime staff:

- Take on roles within production teams for Academy productions where necessary.
- Play an increasing role in the managing of a variety of company affairs, such as venue management, event management, administration, LAMDA exams, Customer Service, sales & marketing.

Candidates will already have and be able to demonstrate/ provide evidence of:

- Teaching experience, providing coaching within schools or performing arts schools.
- Experience in direction and production of youth performances for varying ages, or recent employment in theatre productions.

- Be able to provide strong references about the quality of their teaching and/or directing
- Be youthful and enthusiastic in nature, passionate about children, teaching, and the theatre

  sociable and love to work as part of an energetic team
- Relish the opportunity of spending time and working in Switzerland
- Want the next stage of their career to be in education of the performing arts
