Our Performance & Workshop

Become a Disney Performer for the day!

Through the Disney Performing Arts OnStage programme, our students will have the unique opportunity to perform a 20-minute musical theatre showcase live on stage in Disneyland Paris on **Sunday 28 June 2026** (time TBC).

Alongside the performance, students will also take part in an exclusive Disney workshop led by Disney professionals, developing performance techniques, professionalism, and teamwork, all with that extra sprinkling of Disney magic.

Our Accommodation

We will be staying at Disney's Hotel Cheyenne.



Saddle up for the Wild West! These Toy Story-themed, recently refurbished rooms (2-4 beds) come with air-conditioning, Disney and international TV channels, and a ceiling fan. The hotel is just a 20-minute walk or a short shuttle ride from the Disney Parks.

Our Travel

For students joining the **Fully Chaperoned package**, train travel between Geneva and Paris is included in the total price.

For families joining us, we know that every situation is different - some may wish to drive, others to fly, and some to travel with us by train. Because of this, travel is not included in the family packages. The train times shown in this pack are for guidance only, but if you would like to join our Simply Theatre group on the train, we can happily arrange this for you at an additional cost.

Our Food & Drink

For students on the **Fully Chaperoned package**, all meals are included in the price. This means breakfast at the hotel each morning, plus lunch and dinner in the Disney Parks. We'll make sure students eat well, stay fueled for the excitement of the day, and have the chance to enjoy a variety of Disney dining options together as a group.

For those on the **Family package**, a continental breakfast at the hotel is included. Families are then free to choose where and when they would like to eat lunch and dinner - whether that's exploring Disney's wide choice of restaurants and cafés, or taking a break outside the parks.

Our Packages

There are two options to choose from when signing up for this experience:

- 1) **FULLY CHAPERONED*** – Our Simply Theatre staff will accompany your child from Geneva station all the way to Paris and back. Once in Disneyland Paris, students will be in small groups of no more than six, chaperoned at all times - in the parks, at mealtimes, and in the hotel.

Students will share a room with one, two or three others of a similar age and gender, with their supervisors' room located nearby. Our staff can also look after spending money if you wish, helping ensure your child has the best possible time with their friends and the group while enjoying the full Disney experience.

- 2) **NON-CHAPERONED** – For families who prefer to travel and stay together, your child will remain in your care throughout the trip, except during rehearsals, the workshop, and the performance. You'll be responsible for making sure they are with us at the right times.

Students will stay in your family room but, along with you, are warmly welcome to join Simply Theatre group meet-ups in the parks - including some meals, rides, and photo opportunities.

****The fully chaperoned package is only available for ages 10+***

Non-chaperoned packages do not include travel, supervision (outside of rehearsals and performance), lunch, dinner, or drinks.

Payment Schedule

- A **10% deposit** is due when you accept your place (following a successful audition).
- The remaining balance is payable by **10 March 2026**.

Instalment Plan

- To help spread the cost, we offer a payment plan.
- Payments are made on the **10th of each month**, beginning **10 November 2025** and running through to **10 June 2026** (8 instalments).
- Please note: **10 March 2026** is also the final date we can make any changes to your booking without Disney fees being applied.

*These rehearsals will take place in Geneva. Students from regions outside Geneva will need to be chaperoned by a parent during these weekends.

We are not able to provide accommodation, and families should make their own arrangements. If you are struggling to find a solution, please let us know - in exceptional cases, we may be able to connect you with a Geneva family willing to host.

The Audition

To be part of this once-in-a-lifetime experience, students will need to submit a video audition.

What to prepare:

1. **Song** – Perform a song of your choice to a backing track (not a vocal track). This can be a Disney song, or another piece in a similar style. NOT a pop song or similar.
2. **Dance** – learn the short routine from this video:

- Start from “my little soda pop” on count 5.
- You may slow down the video on YouTube if you need to learn the moves more carefully. To do this: click the settings wheel at the bottom right of the video → select Playback speed → choose a slower speed.
- You can also slow down the song itself on YouTube in the same way.

This routine isn't about being perfect — it's about showing us your dynamic dance ability and, most importantly, your performance energy.

Remember: Disney loves to see big characterful faces — so give it everything and face, face, face!

3. How to submit:

- Film your audition.
- Start by introducing yourself to camera.
- Perform your **song first**, then your **dance routine**.
- Upload your video to YouTube, Vimeo, or another hosting site as a private/unlisted link. It must be one video file – not multiple.
- Once uploaded, complete the online application form and include your video link.

Tips for Your Video Audition

- Practice both your song and dance until you feel confident.
- Ask someone to help you press play for the tracks.
- For the dance, film in full body view (not just head and shoulders).
- Aim for a plain background if possible. If not, make sure you are well lit and avoid having light behind you (e.g. close curtains).
- At the end, thank the panel and then stop filming.

A note on the 'Disney Audition'?

Disneyland Paris requires Simply Theatre to submit a filmed rehearsal performance for approval. We will rehearse and record over two weekends in November. While rejection is very unlikely, in the event that Disney do not approve us, any monies paid will be refunded and the project will be cancelled.

Terms and Conditions

- Students must have parental/guardian permission.
- Applications and auditions must be submitted by the deadline. Late applications may not be accepted.
- Submitting an application is an expression of interest. If a place is offered and accepted, this becomes a commitment to pay in full.
- Fees are non-refundable once confirmed, unless recoverable through Disney's Terms & Conditions.
- Parents are responsible for valid travel documents (passport/visa if applicable) and for travel/health insurance.
- Simply Theatre is not a travel agency. We organise travel and accommodation solely to facilitate the performance.
- Simply Theatre cannot be held responsible for events beyond our control (e.g. strikes, severe weather, travel disruption). Additional costs must be covered by parents.
- Students must follow Simply Theatre rules. No alcohol or smoking is permitted. Serious or repeated breaches may result in a student being sent home at the parent's expense.
- Simply Theatre is not responsible for lost or stolen items.

A full set of Terms & Conditions will be provided to successful applicants.
